SWC 513 – Capstone Project in Spiritual Wellness and Community Health

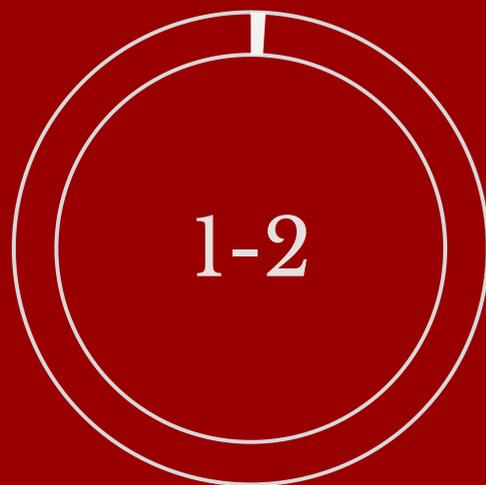
